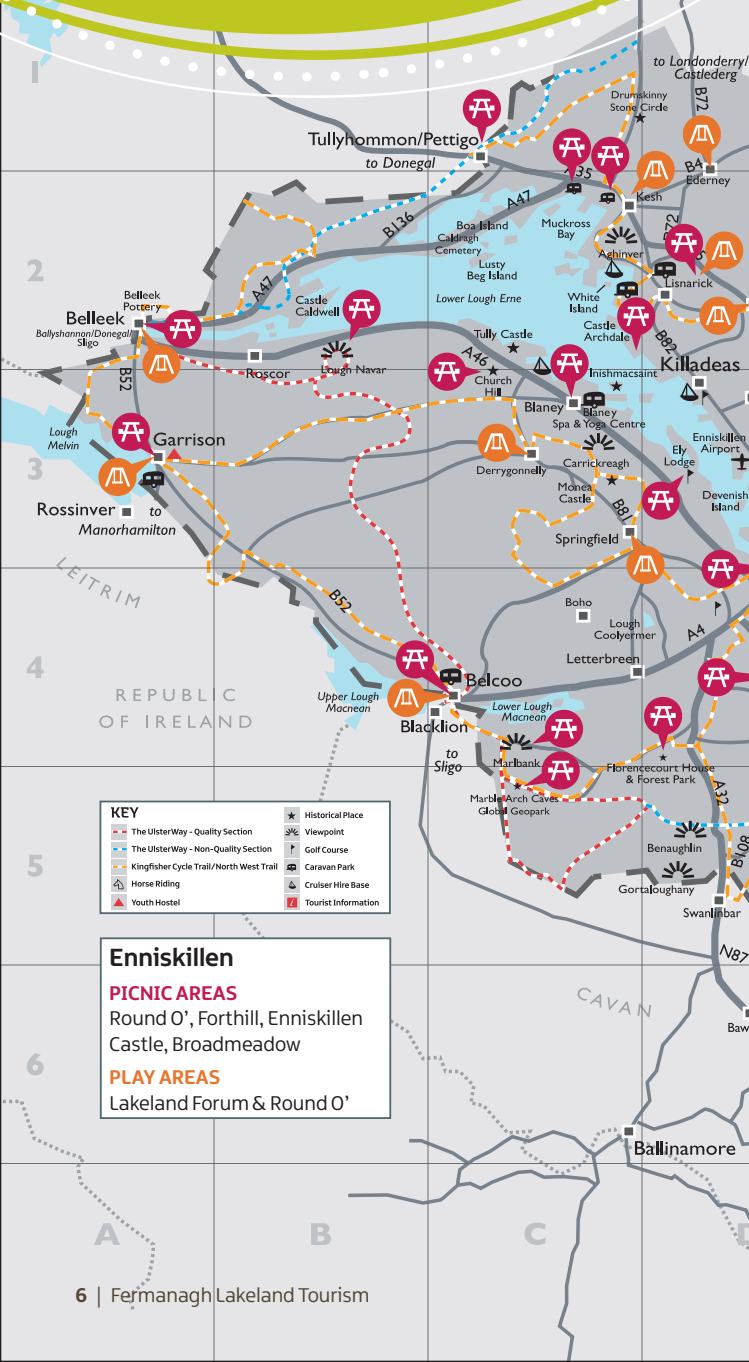

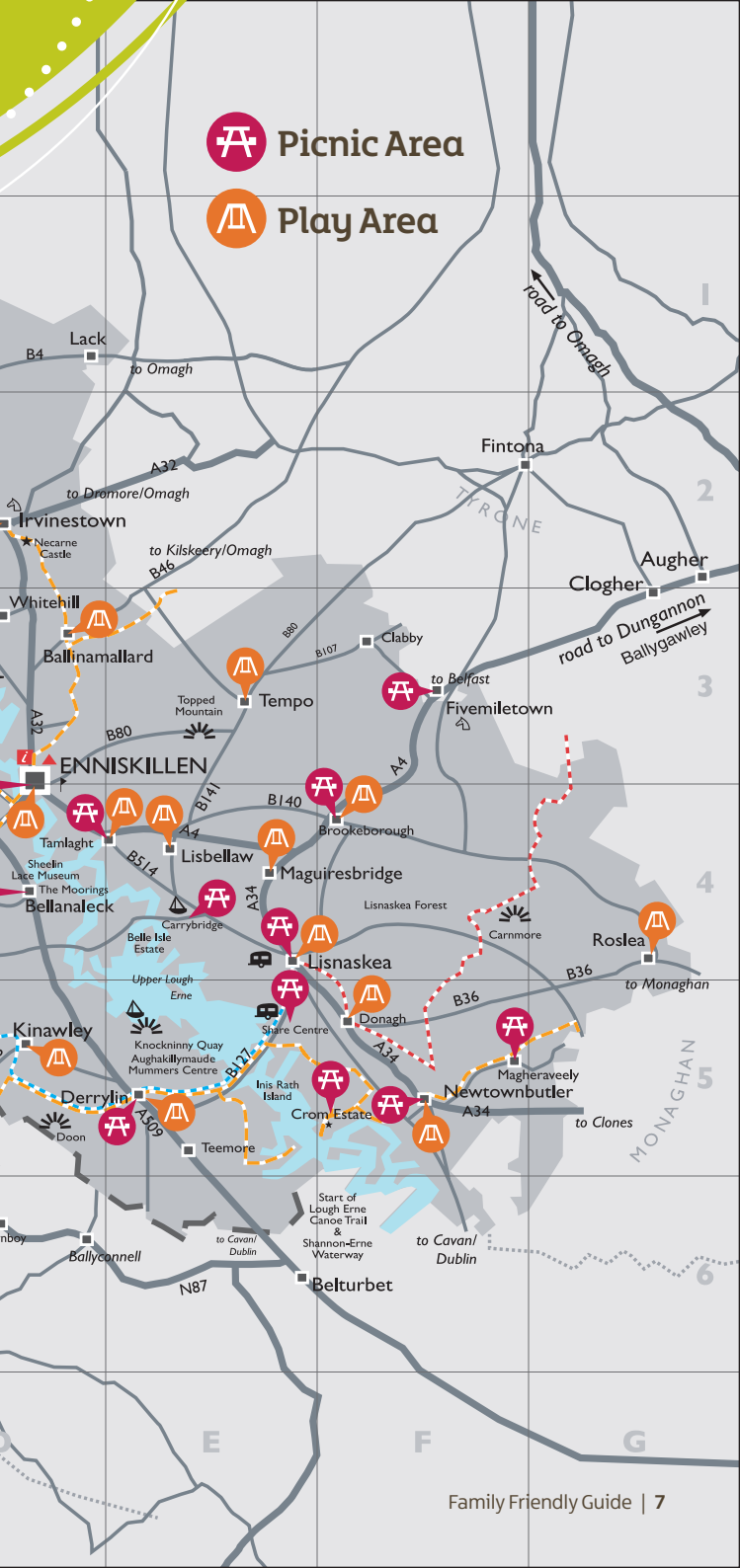

Themed Tours

Take a trip back to 1891 as you visit Castle Coole, the setting for the coming of age party for Amar, Viscount Corry. Enjoy a guided tour of the house by either the footman or maid which is themed around the preparations for the party, and feel the buzz of excitement that is building amongst both the upstairs and downstairs staff as they get ready to welcome gentry from across the country to the home of which they are so proud. The tour concludes in the impressive basement, as it is brought to life by costumed members of the staff who are busily getting ready for the party.

The Scullery

The Scullery at Castle Coole has recently been opened and is located at the top of the Servants Tunnel in the basement of the house. Children's Tours


